

## ***PE kit***

Children must have a separate change of clothes for PE. Your child will be taught PE on Mondays and Wednesdays. However we recommend that PE kits are kept at school to allow for timetable changes at short notice. As it is the summer term PE will be outdoors as much as possible.

As you can appreciate most uniforms will be very similar to those of other children. We would therefore ask that all items being brought into school be clearly marked.

## ***Jewellery***

While not recommended, watches and small stud earrings may be worn for school. However, the wearing of all other jewellery (rings, bracelets, necklaces etc.) is not allowed in school as it is easily broken or lost and can become a hazard.

All jewellery **must** be removed for PE. Staff are not permitted to remove earrings, so the child must be able to remove and replace their own earrings.

Children are responsible for their own earrings, especially when they are not being worn.

## ***Personal belongings***

Valuable items, toys or games and large amounts of money should not be brought to school unless prior arrangements have been made. The school cannot accept responsibility for lost, missing or damaged items.

## ***Uniform***

Please remember that school uniform is compulsory. For more details of what your child can/cannot wear, please ask at the school office.



# A guide to Year 5

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Taking an active role in your child's learning is one of the best ways you can help your child do better in school and in life. The interest that families show in their child's schooling can have a powerful influence on their success.

We hope that you will support us as a Year 5 team, in supporting your child during this year.

## ***The Year 5 curriculum***

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Each half term we explore a different theme with links running through all subjects including English, Maths, Science and ICT.

The Y5 topics for the Summer term will be:

**What did the Egyptians do for us?**  
(History focus)

**Would you like to live in my city?**  
(Geography focus)

## ***Curriculum***

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**Maths** - In Maths the children will be learning about:

Decimals, measurements, mean, percentages, angles, properties of triangles and 4 sided shapes, geometrical construction, volume of cubes and cuboids.

**English** - During English lessons the children will be learning to write a losing story, a newspaper report, an overcoming a monster story and a persuasion text. We will also be integrating Spelling, Punctuation and Grammar into the English lessons. The children will practice their new spellings each week using their zappers.

**Science** - The children will be learning about living things and their habitats and about how humans change.

**Computing** - How to use Power point effectively and coding.

**PE** - This term the children will be learning cricket which will again result in a year group tournament. They will also be learning multisports.

**Art/design projects** - We will be having an Egyptian parent art morning to make jewelry, masks and headdresses. The children will also make canopic jars and pyramids. For the my city project they will be making a model of their own city.

## ***Attendance and punctuality***

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Attendance and Punctuality are linked to how well your child achieves. Those pupils who arrive in school on time, and whose attendance is good, perform significantly better than those who miss periods of school or are regularly late. Our school attendance target is 96.5%

## ***Behaviour***

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Each Y5 class has produced a Class charter, which outline the rules that children are expected to follow. Your child will receive smileys for when they work hard in lessons and follow the school rules.

This term our school values are: pride, respect and determination.

## ***Extra Activities***

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This term the children will be taking part in a year group cricket event. There will also be an Egyptian art morning for parents to join the children in their learning.
